Where is the Child Advocacy Center of Warren County?

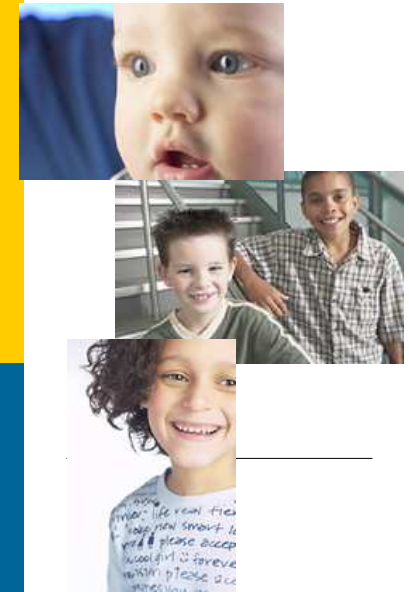
Directions

What is a Children's Advocacy Center?

Children's Advocacy Centers (CACs) are facility-based partnerships designed to coordinate multidisciplinary investigations of child abuse in a child friendly environment. They are playing an increasingly important role in shaping the community response to child abuse victims and their families. CACs are considered the best practice model of investigating child abuse and providing services to child victims.

- Child interviews
- Medical evaluations
- Victim Support/advocacy
- Therapeutic intervention
- Investigative services
- Prosecutorial services
- Community education
- Multidisciplinary meetings



- 1 in 4 girls and 1 in 6 boys will be sexually abused by the age of 18
- 4 children die each day from child maltreatment
- Child maltreatment can cause long-term effects for children and society
- Children deserve the best response that we can give them
